

Certificate in Fundamental Inspection, Testing and Initial Verification.

City & Guilds 2392-10

This new qualification has been developed in order to meet the needs of the electrical contracting industry.

Objective:

It is intended to provide candidates with an introduction to the fundamentals of inspection, testing and initial verification of electrical installations.

It is aimed at practising electricians who have not carried out inspection and testing since qualifying or who require some update training.

It is also suitable for those coming into the industry with limited experience of inspection and testing.

Candidates who achieve this qualification could progress onto the Certificate in Inspection, Testing and Certification of Electrical Installations (2391-10).

Approach to the Course and Assessment:

This is very much a 'hands-on' course. All underpinning knowledge requirements will be supported by frequent practical activities.

Assessment will be by:

This qualification is assessed by a **CLOSED BOOK**, 50 multiple choice question paper online covering the underpinning knowledge relating to the fundamental inspection, testing and initial verification of electrical installations, as required by BS 7671:2008

A practical test carried out under supervision covering the range of inspections, tests, verification and recording of information and results for a new electrical installation, as required by BS7671:2008

Duration:

4 days including GOLA (Global Online Assessment)

People who might benefit from this course are electricians who have little or no experience in electrical testing, or those that require an update to their knowledge before going on to do the City and Guilds 2391. It's also particularly suitable for PART P Domestic Installers.

Entry Requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements for candidates undertaking this qualification. However, delegates must have a basic knowledge and understanding of electrical theory and principles.
